PATTERN Crochet Doily "Seaside" ©

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Description: Simple crochet doily pattern – colourful and festive - to match Crochet Coasters SEASIDE pattern.

Pattern Basics

Stitches: single, double, treble crochet

Yarn: Patons 100% Cotton DK

Hook: 4.5mm

Gauge: not critical

Measurements: 11.5ins (29cms) diameter

Terminology: US crochet terms; metric hook sizes.

Before you begin:

- read the pattern to end;
- select yarn and hook.

Doily Pattern

With CC1

Rnd 1: Magic loop, ch3 (counts as 1st dc), 11dc into loop, join with sl st into 2nd ch of ch3. (12dc).

Rnd 2: Ch1, 2sc in same st, and every st to end, join with sl st in ch1. (24sts). **Change to MC**

Rnd 3: Ch3 (counts as 1st dc), dc in same st, *2dc in next st, dc in next st, rep from * to end, join with sl st in 2nd ch of ch3. (36dc)

Rnd 4: Ch1, sc in same st, sc in next st and every st to end, join with sl st in ch1. (36sts) **Change to CC1.**

Rnd 5: Ch3, (counts as 1st dc), dc in same st *dc in next 2sts, 2dc in next st, rep from * to end ending with dc in last 2sts, join with sl st in 2nd ch of ch3. (48sts) **Change to MC.**

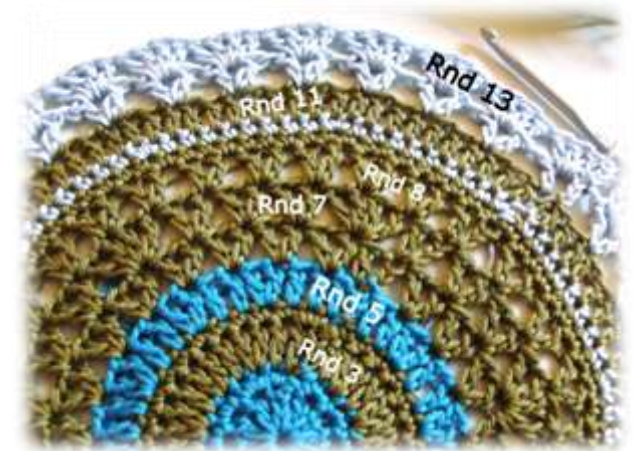
Rnd 6: Ch4, dc in same st (counts as 1st V-st), *skip next st, V-st in next st, rep from * to end, join with sl st in 2nd ch of ch4. (24 V-sts)



Rnd 7 & 8: *Work all V-sts into the st between V-sts of previous rnd.*

Rnd 7: Ch4, dc in same st (counts as 1st V-st), *2V-st into next st, V-st in next 3sts, rep from * to **, to end, join with sl st in 2nd ch of Ch4. (30 V-sts)

Rnd 8: Ch4, dc in same st (counts as 1st V-st), V-st into each st between V-sts to end, join with sl st in 2nd ch of ch4.



Rnd 9: Ch1, sc in same st, sc in each st to end, join with sl st in ch1. (90sts) **Change to CC2.**

Rnd 10: Ch1, *2sc in same st, sc in next 8sts, rep from * to end, join with sl st in ch1. (100sts) **Change to MC.**

Rnd 11: Ch3, dc in each st to end, join with sl st in **top of ch3.** **Change to CC2.**

Rnd 12: Ch4, dc in same st (counts as 1st V-st), ch1, *skip next 2sts, V-st in next st, ch1, rep from * to end, join with sl st in 2nd ch of ch4. (33 V-sts)

Rnd 13: *Work into ch1 sp of V-st.* Ch3, 3dc in ch1 sp of V-st, *4dc in ch1 sp of next V-st, rep from * to end, join with sl st in 2nd ch of ch3. **Change to CC1.**



Rnd 14: Ch1, sc in same st, and every st to end, join with sl st in ch1.

Rnd 15: *Ch4, 3tr in same st, skip 3sts, sl st in next st, rep from * to end, join with sl st. **Cut yarn, hide ends.**

Abbreviations:

Ch = chain; **sc** = single crochet; **dc** = double crochet; **sl st** = slip stitch; **st/sts** = stitch/es; **rep** = repeat; **beg** = begin/beginning; **MC** = main colour; **CC1** = contrast colour 1; **CC2** = contrast colour 2.

Special Abbreviations:

V-st = V-stitch = 1dc, 1ch, 1dc in same stitch

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
