Description: "It's a man thing" - long crochet mobius with a country tracks texture pattern, designed to roll. Keep it simple - worked in the round, no seams to sew.

Skill Level:  **EASY**

Yarn:  **Jarol** "Pure British Wool Aran" 100g **OR** any other similar yarn

Substitute yarns: *Always match Tension/Gauge and Hook recommendations on **yarn label** to the yarn used in this pattern.*

Hook: Yarn label:- 5mm
This pattern: 6mm

Stitches: sc, hdc, dc, bobble

Gauge/Tension: Yarn label: 19sts to 24 rows. **This pattern:** 10sts in dc to 4in (10.2cm)
Gauge is not critical in this pattern.

Measurements: Circumference approx. 45in (114.3cm); width 6in (15.2cm)

Size: Mens Average

Terminology: USA - American crochet terms

Before you begin:

- read the pattern to end;
- select yarn and hook.

Adjusting size: To make a smaller/larger sized mobius; calculate the number of stitches needed to match circumference **OR** change yarn and hook size. [See Hints for smaller and larger sizes at end of pattern.](#)

This pattern: uses multiples of 4 stitches.

Pattern – Foundationless dc row

With MC and 6mm hook

Rnd 1: FDC for a total of 100 sts, (measuring approx. 45ins) **twist**, and join with sl st in bottom of starting ch3.

see Special Notes for FDC row and joining.

Cont along base of FDC row as follows: Sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next and every st around, **now** your next rnd begins in the top of starting ch3.



Bobble Pattern

Rnd 2: *Dc in next 3sts, bo in next st, ch1,** rep from * to ** all the way round, working the pattern into each st, (including the joining sl st, sc, hdc, and dc), ending with bo in last dc.

Rnd 3: dc in next 3sts *skip top of bo, bo in ch1, dc in next 3sts,** rep from * to ** all round, ending with bo in last ch1.



Rnd 4: Rep Rnd 3. **Change to CC in last ch1.**

Rnd 5: *2dc in next 2sts, dc2tog over next 2sts (skipping top of bo),** rep from * to **all round, ending with dc2tog, dc in next st, hdc in same st, hdc in next st, sc in same st, sl st in next 2sts. **Cut yarn and hide ends.**

Special Notes

FDC = foundationless double crochet

Ch 3, yo, and insert your hook in 3rd ch from hook, yo, draw up a loop, (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through one loop, (1ch made - this is the chain that you will work your next stitch into), **NOW** finish your first dc, [yo, draw through two loops on hook], 2 times (1st dc made).

*Yo, insert hook under one loop of chain at bottom of stitch just made, yo and pull up loop, (3 loops on hook)

yo and draw through one loop (1ch made) [yo, draw through two loops on hook], 2 times,

Repeat from * for as many stitches as needed.

Joining:

When you have crocheted your foundationless dc row to the length you desire

- make sure you keep the row straight
- bring the two ends together
- then twist the beginning of your work
- sl st into the bottom of beginning ch3 (not the top)
- sc into the next st
- hdc into the next st
- dc into the next st and remaining sts around
- at the beginning of the round, work a dc into the top of the beginning ch3
- there will be a hole where the twist was made, it can be stitched up with the yarn tail upon finishing.

Pattern Adjustments

To adjust the size of the mobius, decide on the length you wish to make.

Start your FDC row and continue until it is close to your required length. You can gently stretch the starting row to see how much longer it will be. Adjust stitch count accordingly. Remember the stitch pattern requires you use multiples of four (4) stitches. **Easy to adjust size up or down.**

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Bobble Stitch Explanation:

The bobble stitch used in this pattern is created from a series of double crochet stitches which are joined at both the top and bottom. This bobble is made from five incomplete double crochet stitches, joined by a "yarn over" at the completion of the stitch.

How to make a 5dc bobble:-

YO, insert hook in next st, YO, pull up a loop, YO, pull through two loops, [YO, insert hook in same st, YO, pull up a loop, YO, pull through two loops] 4 times, YO, and draw through all loops on hook.
